ARIZONA ART ALLIANCE

For the PAG Gallery show running from June 12th thru June 23rd, we will have 8 panels (16 sides). Deadline for entry forms is May 20th at our final PAG monthly meeting. Make certain I get your entry form by then. Also make sure you have a card taped to the back of your artwork with your name, title of the piece, medium and price. When you deliver your artwork to the Gallery (June 10, 11 am - 2 pm) bring with your artwork a completed PAG logo card. Artwork pickup (if not sold) will be June 24th, 9 to 11 am. The Veterans Art Exhibit to be held at Phoenix City Hall will run from May 20th thru May 31st. Artist Reception at City Hall lobby will be at 10:30 am, May 20th attended by Phoenix Mayor Greg Stanton and other City Officials. Veterans and families are also invited. Only 2-D art will be allowed. Art must have an attached readable ID tag on the back identifying name of artist, title of piece, medium and price. All artwork must be for sale. Artwork and a completed Hold Harmless/Inventory Agreement (available on the website: azartalliance.com, under the forms tab) must be delivered to the Alliance Gallery, 9011 E. Indian Bend Rd., Ste E-1, Scottsdale, between 10 am and 5 pm Tuesday, May 7th through Monday, May 13th.

Following the Alliance exhibit at the Gallery, "Honoring Our Veterans/We Are Family," the next exhibit 2-month show presenting "Hot AZ Art" will run from June 5th through August 4th. All forms needed should be available on the website starting April 30th (www.azartalliance.com, key on forms). For those juried artists with no computer, I will have several sets of forms on the table for our final meeting on May 20th.

The Alliance is continuing dialogue with parties at the Westgate complex in Glendale for a possible westside Gallery. Seeking perhaps an August "opening."

FINALLY, great news for our artists, beginning May 8th, contributions to the Alliance for any SOLD items are reduced from 40% to 30%. HURRAY!

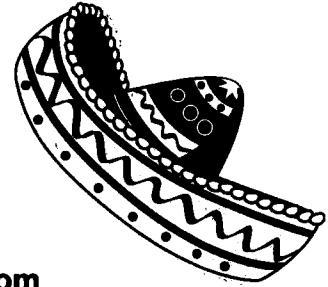

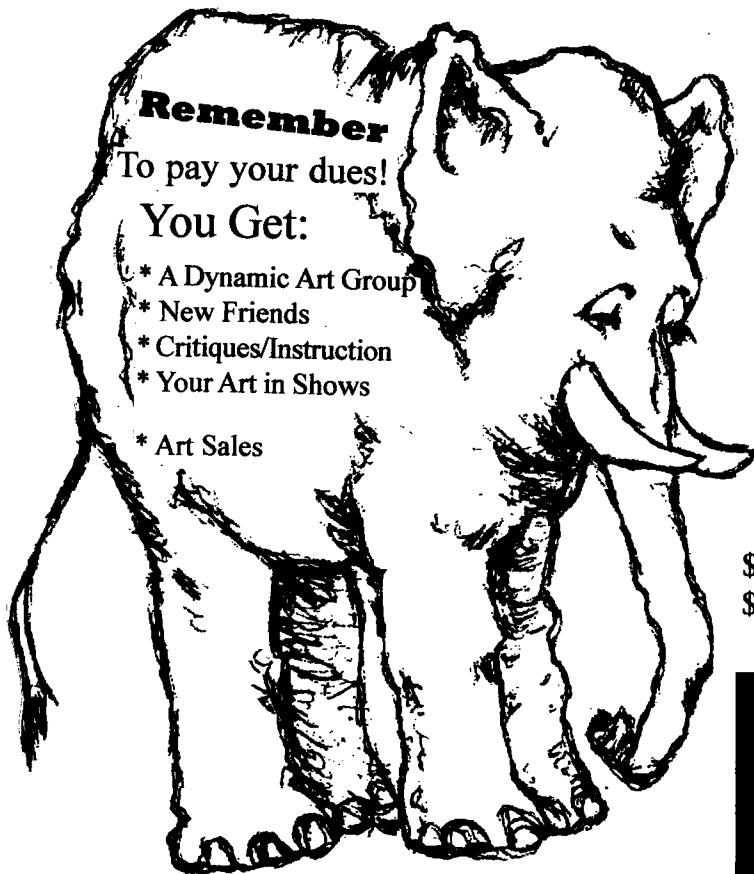
